### ● 출장 중 주요 업무성과 :

#### • WEF 업무 관련

- 2008년부터 WEF가 관리하는 패널데이터를 KDI에 제공할 수 있음. 본래 WEF 패널데이터는 비공개임.
- 내년 1월 개최되는 다보스포럼에 KDI 원장 초청 상황 등을 알아보기로 함. 본래 한국에는 대통령 포함 주요 경제부처 장관 등 총 7명에게 초청장 발송. 올해의 경우 대통령을 제외한 장관 7명이 참석했음. 그러나 전반적으로 한국의 발언권이 약한 상황으로 한국의 적극적 참여 필요한 상황임.
- 내년의 경우 KDI원장이 패널의 역할을 하는 등 여러 상황과 역할을 고려하면서 초청장 발송 상황을 알아보기로 함.
- WEF는 앞으로 지속적인 업무 협력 강화를 위해 KDI 펠로우의 1년 단위 파견을 희망함. (UN 외교관 비자)
- 가장 큰 포럼인 다보스외에 두 번째 주요 포럼인 GROWTH SUMMIT에도 정규 초청장 발송할 수 있음.

#### • WEF 포럼 주요 패널 관련

- 총 400 명 참석으로 120여개국 이상에서 재무장관(개발도상국에서는 주로 재무장관이 참석하고 선진국에서는 학교 교수 또는 기업 CEO 및 주요 인사들이 참석)
- 각 세션 포럼의 구성으로 정부 관계자 1명으로 주로 개도국(이집트, 북마케도니아, 사우디아라비아 등)의 재무장관이 참여하고 학계에서는 1명~2명이 주로 미국과 유럽의 주요 대학 경영학과 교수 또는 경제학과 교수가 참석하고 기업에서는 1명~2명이 CEO(주로 에너지 섹터, 인디아에서 Engro Corp)참석하여 올해 주제인 "Job and Opportunity: Technology"를 논의
- 각 나라가 모두 다른 언어권이지만 통역 없이 모두 영어로만 진행
